★ **L'CHAIM for Grades preK-2.** L'CHAIM provides a foundation for kids and families in Jewish education.

L'CHAIM ("To Life!") meets Sundays, 3:30-5:30 p.m. Additional opportunities include Shabbat B'Yachad ("Sabbath Together") Saturday morning programs and services, holidays and family-led events. Each week ends with a short "kehillah" assembly for everyone.

★ **RUACH LAB for Grades 3-7.** RUACH LAB is our Jewish "laboratory" for the older grades.

RUACH LAB meets Sundays, 3:30-5:30 p.m. The older kids work in a mixed-age group or in smaller grade groups with on-site learning, projects and choices and off-site "chavaya" field trips, explorations and Tikkun Olam projects. Additional opportunities include Shabbat B'Yachad ("Sabbath Together") Saturday morning programs and services, holidays and family-led events.

NOTE: RUACH students in Grades 3-7 are also usually enrolled in Hebrew Havurah on Thursdays and/or B'nei Mitzvah Journey class.
